Accessibility

All 3 churches have an induction loop system. Those with hearing aids can switch them to the "T" position.

Large print hymnbooks are available

All 3 worship spaces, and the halls at Duffus and Hopeman, have reasonable access for wheelchairs. There are disabled access toilet at Spynie Kirk and Hopeman Kirk.

Sunday Services - these are normally around 1 hour long.

Children have the option of going out to Sunday School at Hopeman, and are offered some quiet activities in Duffus and Synie
